

NC State Grange Grant Program – 2023

Voluntary Agricultural District Awareness

Purpose:

Provide grant funding to NC Soil & Water Districts, County Extension or other county agencies assisting local Voluntary Agricultural District (VAD or EVAD) programs to provide VAD members assistance in the purchasing and erection of their respective county VAD sign. Grant funding limited to new signage and materials associated with erection of the signage.

Application Eligibility Requirements:

- Grant applicants must be a County Government agency with an active VAD program.
- The VAD landowner receiving signage using NC State Grange funding must be or become a NC State Grange Member.
- The VAD program must be meet the NCGS 106-737 requirements.
- Deadline for 2023 applications is March 31, 2023.

Grant Funding Information:

- Grant payments are made in 2 installments
 - o ½ draw upon approval of the grant application by NC State Grange
 - o ½ final payment upon proof purchase of signs and erection of the signage
 - Limited to one VAD sign per land parcel in county VAD program. Landowners may have more the one parcel in VAD.
 - VAD sign placement must be viewable from a public road
 - Grantee must provide reasonable documentation for VAD sign, erection materials and placement. Reimbursement limited to \$150 per sign.
- Grants and request for payments are limited to 2 years from date of award by NC State Grange.
- Maximum NC State Grange Grant Amount per VAD program \$4,500
- Grant awards subject to availability of funding

An SDA farmer or rancher is a group whose members have been subject to racial, ethnic, or gender prejudice because of their identity as members of a group without regard to their individual qualities. These groups consist of American Indians or Alaskan Natives, Asians, Blacks or African Americans, Native Hawaiians or other Pacific Islanders, Hispanics, and women.
